  - ICS 100 and 200
  - First Aid at the EMR level, registered in good standing with the Sask College of Paramedics.
- Possess a valid Saskatchewan unrestricted Class 4 driver's license with air brake endorsement (A) or equivalent from another province.
- Airport Firefighting certification and experience would be preferred but not a requirement.

    - Fuel Spills.
    - Airside motor vehicle accidents.
    - Other emergency responses as directed by the Senior Officer on crew.
